PREPARATION

New surfaces All surfaces must be sound, suitably dry and free from anything that will interfere with the

adhesion of the materials to be applied.

Previously decorated surfaces

All surfaces must be sound, suitably dry and free from anything that will interfere with the adhesion of the materials to be applied. Remove all loose, and failing or suspect material.

APPLICATION Apply using a filling knife. Fill all cracks, open joints and small surface defects with Sandtex

Trade Ready Mixed Filler, remove surplus material, finish to match existing and allow to dry.

CLEANING Wash equipment with clean water immediately after use. Do not empty or wash the remains

of Sandtex Trade Ready Mixed Filler into drainage systems.
